Temporary Footpath Closure

North Somerset Council have made us aware of an upcoming temporary footpath closure. Details of this are below.

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL FOOTPATH BETWEEN CABOT WAY & STODELEIGH CLOSE (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE BY PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS) 2024

Notice is hereby given that the North Somerset Council, under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, by virtue of this Notice, for a period of up to twenty-one days commencing on the 4 March 2024, will close, temporarily, to pedestrians and cyclists, the lengths of highway (footpath) specified in the schedule to this notice.

This order is required to complete repairs to subway under Wansborough Road, Weston-super-Mare and will become operative on 4 March 2024 for a maximum period of six months. However, the closure may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 5 days.

UPDATE - The works to repair the subway under Wansborough Road, will take a further few weeks to complete and the footpath is likely to be closed until Friday 22nd March. Should these works be completed before this date, then we will advise of the date for re-opening.

Schedule

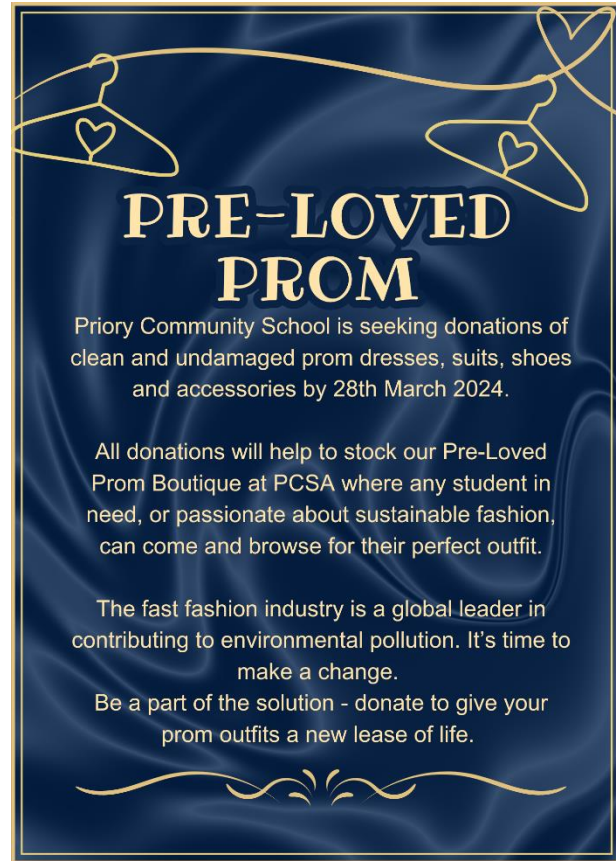
Footpath between Cabot Way & Stodeleigh Close – From a point to the front of No. 43 Cabot Way, Weston-super-Mare continuing along the footpath under the Subway at Wansborough Road to a point where the footpath joins the footpath on Wansborough Road.

Alternative routes

Footpath at Cabot Way, Queensway and across Wansborough Road and vice versa.
