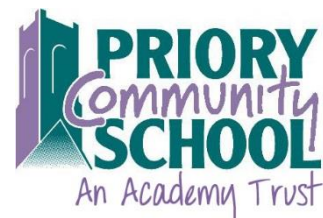

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of their graduation process from Lower School to Upper School, we are arranging a three-day residential trip to London from 5 – 7 July 2017 for our Year 8 students. The trip will provide us with the opportunity to celebrate the success of the academic year and prepare your son/daughter for the challenges of Upper School. Our intention is to take 96 students in the year group. However, this will be dependent upon each student's behaviour. **Any student who receives more than 5 negative points or has less than 97% attendance or has a late arrival mark between Monday 30 January and Friday 31 March (8 school weeks) will be removed from the trip.** Should any serious infringement of behaviour occur between 31 March and the date of travel we reserve the right to remove the student from the trip.


The itinerary your son/daughter follows may vary slightly, as we will be dividing into smaller groups to undertake each activity. Accommodation has been booked at the Lee Valley YHA. Your son/daughter will need a packed lunch for Wednesday 5 July and some money to purchase some food during the return journey on Friday 7 July. All other food will be provided.

There is a strict limit of 96 spaces available. Should the trip be over-subscribed, 96 students will be drawn with a list of reserves. In order for your child to have an opportunity to attend this trip, **please ensure the attached form is returned to Miss Discombe in the Finance Office by Tuesday 31 January 2017.** You will then be informed by letter if your son/daughter has a space on the trip or on the reserves list. The trip will then be available on Parent Pay. The cost of the trip is expected to be £220.
