Computing is delivered at KS3 and as a team we have created a challenging but engaging scheme of work that is designed to prepare our students for the rigor of GCSE. We as a team over the past year have worked hard in developing KS3 and are always looking for new and exciting ways to inspire our students in computing. Our KS3 focus is for students to develop an understanding of the key principles of computer science (including programming) and to equip them with the skills to evaluate and apply information technology to solve problems.

At KS4 students in Years 9, 10 and 11 are offered GCSE Computer Science or BTEC ICT (level 2). GCSE Computing and ICT proved to be a popular choice at KS4 with over 300 students opting to take the subjects at GCSE. Our results overall have been consistently above the national average. The department is always looking for new and innovative ways to expand the curriculum at KS4.

The department and the school are committed to developing a curriculum with a strong focus on Computing. The department also offers BTEC Business Studies (L2) which has seen huge success with 100% D*-P over the past two years. The ability to teach Business Studies would be desirable but not essential. The school facilities include Mac Suites, and twelve Windows ICT suites all of which have the latest software

WCSA is a rapidly improving, visionary, new Academy in Worle for ages 11-16. OFSTED granted Worle a glowing bill of health in December 2016 praising it for a range of measures including safety, behavior, and teaching. The school now aims to be OFSTED outstanding like its partner school Priory Community School Academy. GCSE results are on course to be exceptional this year, with extensive encouragement and "tracking" of every single student to ensure success. WCSA is now a happy school with small class sizes, exceptional teaching and great relationships between staff and students.
