Dear Parents/Carers

We are pleased to be able to offer Year 7 Students an opportunity to extend their learning with a range of enrichment trips and activities through the school year.

- At Chepstow Castle students will trace the history of the castle, study how warfare developed over the centuries and gain an insight into life in a medieval castle.
- At Hoddors Coombe on the Quantocks students will be studying how rivers work. Practical and sensible outdoor clothing needs to be worn, not school uniform, **(possible muddy conditions)** including wellington boots/old trainers (for wearing in the river), spare socks plus a black bag for possible wet clothes. Students will be walking at least 6km and will, therefore, need drinking water and sun protection if the weather is hot.

I am sure you will agree that these are valuable and exciting experiences and it would be appreciated if you could make a donation of **£17.50** towards your child's trips. The price includes admission fees, coach journeys and insurance. The donation is voluntary, but if insufficient contributions are received then activities may need to be cancelled.
